- September 24 A parent information evening for the University of Alberta was held for Grade 12's and was well-attended with lots of questions answered. Parents and students are reminded that applications for the University of Alberta open October 1st. A discussion was also had about the possibility of having a Grade 10 and Grade 11 parent information evening.
- September 27 Senior sunrise for the Grade 12's is at 7 AM. The school will supply hot chocolate and Timbits.
- September 30 Truth & Reconciliation Day is a day of reflection, recognition, and commemoration of the tragic impact of residential schools in Canada. There will be no classes this day. There will be Truth & Reconciliation activities during the October 1 PLT.

- Communication Replacing the monthly newsletter, a new initiative was started this year
 wherein announcements are being posted daily to both the Mac website and Instagram
 account. A suggestion was made for the announcements to be posted for a full week
 instead of removing them daily, with the newest one put at the top of the page.
- Personal Mobile Devices Students are respecting the new policy so far, and a positive difference in classroom learning has been observed. One drawback noted, however, is the higher demand of additional technology from the school.
- School Entrance Access Feedback was received by parents whose children are in after school activities, not being able to gain timely access to the school to watch their kids. The school is looking at numbering the entrances, with all doors being locked down at 4 PM. A discussion was had about hiring students to stay behind and do homework from 4-7 PM, with the job of letting parents in who ring the doorbell. More information will come down about this soon.
- 2023-24 Diploma Exam Results The diploma exam results from January and June 2024 were reviewed with parents in comparison to the rest of the province. In most subjects, Mac scored above the provincial average for standard of excellence. This data will be reviewed by the staff for future exam preparation.
